11. OBSERVATIONS/DEFICIENCES

The total allocation of seats during the year 2011-12 was 300 including management and supernumerary seats but during the Academic year 2012-13, the college could only fill up 242 seats including the management and supernumerary seats. As per student teacher ratio of 1:15, the college should have 17 teachers including the college Principal but the college has appointed 16 teachers on permanent basis and are being paid @ Rs.12000/- plus annual of Rs. 275/- p.m. However, Committee noticed that in reference to last year is Compliance report the college has not made the permanent appointment of the Principal till the date of Inspection i.e. 15/01/2013, but the College Management submitted the Selection Committee proceeding held on 06/03/2013 and Mrs. Poonam Chib has been appointed as the Principal of the College.

FINAL RECOMMENDATIONS

After conducting inspection of the College vis-à-vis the prescribed norms, the Committee recommended that Adarsh College of Education, Tarore Bridge National Highway, Distt Samba, J&K may be granted extension of temporary/provisional affiliation for imparting instruction in Bachelor's Degree Course in Education (B.Ed.) for the academic session 2012-13 subject to compliance report for removal of deficiencies pointed out by the Inspection team before the start of the session.
