## 11. OBSERVATIONS/DEFICIENCIES

1. The seat allocation of the College is $-(\mathrm{i})$ intake $=300$ Management $=24$ seats, supernumerary seats $=10$ (five each for the University and the College) meaning thereby the college was having 334 seats in the academic session 2011-12. As per student teacher ratio of 1:15 the college should have 20 permanent faculty members.
2. The college is having 18 faculty members out of which 10 faculty members have been appointed by the Statutory Selection Committee on permanent basis and the remaining 08 faculty members have been appointed by the Management on adhoc / part time basis.
3. The Committee Members desired that the faculty members including the Principal working on adhoc basis be regularized at an earliest.

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## FINAL RECOMMENDATIONS

After conducting inspection of the College vis-à-vis the prescribed norms, the Committee recommended that National College of Education, Purkhoo Camp, Doom, Jammu be granted extension of temporary/provisional affiliation for imparting instructions in Bachelor's Degree Course in Education (B.Ed.) for the academic session 2012-13 subject to the condition that the Chairman of the college shall submit compliance report for removal of deficiencies pointed out by the Inspection team within one month from the date of issuance of inspection report.
