## OBSERVATIONS/DEFICIENCIES/SUGESSTIONS (IF ANY):

The Committee pointed out following deficiencies on the inspection of the college:

1. The committee observed that the college has only 6 regular lecturers, while one is working on adhoc basis, it was observed by the committee that out of the faculty appointed through selection committee the college management has terminated the services of two teachers without

- discussing the issue with the management committee of the college or intimating the same to university authorities.
- 2. The principal informed that the librarian is on unauthorized leave since two months without any application. The committee noted that there had been no purchase of books since 2012, the reasons were unexplainable, no journals and magazines are being subscribed by the college that showed stagnation in academic growth of the college.
- 3. The Committee took a serious note of the lapse on part of the management in not paying salary of the employees since 5 months now, the members observed that this was a casual feature and was even reported in the inspection report of session 2012. The committee directed the management to release the salary immediately and send the copy of the bank statement to the office of CDC. The committee asked the college management to submit its audited reports so that the committee can see where has the tuition fee collected by the college been utilised.
  - 4. The pay of the staff is not defined as per state or UGC norms, no annual increments are being given to the members even after their appointment through proper selection process. The committee observed that the college has maximum intake and all seats were filled there was no observable financial crunch, thus paying regular and defined salary should not have been listed as a deficiency.
  - 5. The record of management committee was not made available to the committee, thereby the committee questioned the approval of the staff selected through selection committee. Also the members apprised the chairperson that management committee meetings should be convened twice in an academic year as per statutes governing affiliation of Non- Govt colleges.

## FINAL RECOMENDATIONS OF THE INSPECTION COMMITTEE:

The Committee, therefore, recommends the grant of temporary affiliation in favour of Calliope College of Education for the academic session 2014-2015 keeping in view the future of the stakeholders but recommends that extension for the session 2015-16 be only given after the Chairman of the college removes all the deficiencies mentioned above in a months' time.
