11. OBSERVATIONS/DEFICIENCIES

The Inspection Team made the following observations:

- 1. The adequacy of staff strength vis-a-vis number of students i.e. Teacher: Student Ratio (1:15) was not maintained properly by the college. The college has Nineteen (19) teachers (16 permanent and 3 Adhoc). The college has total seats of 334. So the inspection team observed that the college was not having the adequate staff strength, the college required twenty two (22) permanent teachers appointed through proper selection committee constituted by University of Jammu as per their intake. The Committee members desired that the faculty working on Adhoc Basis be regularized as soon as possible.
- 2. The last management committee meeting was held in the college in August 2012.
- 3. The last Selection Committee Meeting was held in the college in June 2012.
- 4. Library facility given by the college to the student was adequate. But the number of books in the library and the amount spent per year for purchasing books was not adequate. There are total of 8822 books in the library. In the year 2011-2012, total of 184 books amounting to Rs. 72305 were added. There are total of 362 journals in the library.
- 5. Student facilities provided by the college to the students such as Social Activities, Sports, NSS etc. was adequate.
- 6. There are total of 20 computers in the Computer lab. Out of which 5 computers are having Internet connection with a speed of 100MBPS. In addition to it there is one laptop as well.

12. FINAL RECOMANDATION

The Inspection team recommends that the college be affiliated provisionally for imparting instructions to B.Ed. programme for the academic session 2012-2013 only after obtaining the compliance report from the management and removal of deficiency within a stipulated period.
