Observations / Deficiencies:

The Inspection committee observed that:

- 1. The college has 17 faculty members selected through selection committee however the college require 22 teachers as per 1:15 teacher- student ratio.
- 2. The college has appointed the teachers only on the recommendations of the selection committee convened on 31st October 2011 without the approval of management committee. There are two more teachers appointed on contractual basis, still there is shortage of three teachers.
- 3. The committee advised the management to convene the management committee meeting at an earliest to regularise the appointments made by the college.
- 4. The college has total of 2103 books in the library but no book has been purchased in the last academic session.
- 5. The college has although paid for the subscription of three journals, none were found to be regularly subscribed by the college. One periodical namely **India today** was present at the time of inspection. No international journal or online journals are subscribed by the college.
- 6. The committee noticed that the computer laboratory had only 8 computers, which was pointed out as deficiency in the last inspection and no computer was added since then, which contradicted the letter issued to CDC by the college vide letter no. HCE/11-12/Gen/42 dated 20th May 2012, wherein the college has submitted a compliance report that all deficiencies as pointed out in the inspection report have been removed.

- 7. On the day of inspection hardly 70 students were found present, the attendance of the students as reported by the principal was every time around 100 students.
- 8. On the academic front the college had organised one seminar and workshop in the whole session, no guest lectures by educationists from state or university have been organised.
- 9. The salary of the lecturers was also not found as per norms by the inspection committee. The college is paying different salaries ranging from Rs. 6000/- for part time lecturer to Rs. 11000/- for permanent lecturer, working in the college since inception of the college.
- 10. The salary structure of (Rs 8000+ 50% D.A) plus annual increments are not being followed by the college, also the mode of payment of salary is still through cheques, which has been changed by CDC since long.
- 11. The college is having a permanent principal working for last 11 years but she had little knowledge about the university norms.

FINAL RECOMMENDATIONS

The Committee, recommends the grant of extension of temporary/ provisional affiliation in favour of Harvard College of Education, Airport Road Jammu for the academic session 2012-2013 only on the condition that the chairman of the college shall remove the deficiencies pointed out by the inspection team as indicated in the inspection report within one month and submit a compliance report along with supporting documents to the office of College development council.
