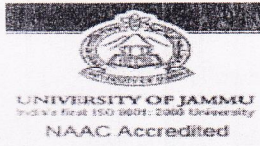


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
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OBSERVATIONS/DEFICIENCIES:

1. The PPT (Power Point Presentation) was not made as there was no responsible person from the college administration/Management to have undertaken the responsibility of the Presentation.
2. Principal of the said college was unavailable and the Management provided different stories about the location of the Principal. However, the Vice-Principal present was not authorized by any competent body to have acted on behalf of Principal.
3. The Principal of the College has not been selected through proper Selection Committee as evident from the available records.
4. The Teacher-Student ratio (1:15) is maintained by the college as there are 11 teachers (Seven through proper Selection Committee and four on Contractual basis) against an admitted student strength of 152 for the session 2014-15. However, the college should have more faculty members on permanent basis as per UGC/AICTE norms.
5. The Inspection committee members observed that the salary to the faculty members is not being paid as per UGC/AICTE norms.
6. No record was available for Management Committee meeting beyond 2006. The same observation was pointed out by the Committee carrying inspection of the college on 21-12-2012.
7. The number of students present in total including all the three sections is 23 against an admitted strength of 152. This is a situation regarding the number of students attending the college on a day when the University team visiting the college is notified in advance.
8. The college is said to have purchased books worth Rs.48, 420/- during the 2012. The same observation was pointed out by the Committee carrying inspection of the college on 21-12-2012. However, no bills are available with the college for this purchase. During the last two






years, no book purchase has been realized. The Librarian was shown to have been absent where as the committee is convinced that the college is functioning without a Librarian.

9. The college did not provide any evidence with regard to students having participated in any Social Activities, Sports and Extracurricular Activities.
10. The Committee has confiscated the Attendance Register of the students wherein no attendance has been marked for the months of September-2014, October-2014, November-2014, partial attendance for December-2014 and no attendance for the period under report for January-2015 (The attendance registers (03) are being submitted to the office of the CDC, University of Jammu along with the report).


FINAL RECOMENDATIONS OF THE INSPECTION COMMITTEE:

After conducting the inspection of the college vis-à-vis the prescribed norms, the committee recommended that the college be granted extension of temporary/provisional affiliation for imparting instructions in Bachelor's Degree Course in Education (B.Ed.) for the academic session 2014-15 subject to the condition that the Chairman of the college shall submit compliance report for removal of deficiencies pointed out by the Inspection team.


