BSERVATIONS/DEFICIENCIES

The Inspection Team made the following observations:

- 1. The adequacy of staff strength vis-a-vis number of students i.e. Teacher: Student Ratio (1:20) was not maintained properly by the college. The college has eighteen (18) teachers (17 permanent and 1 Adhoc). The college has total seats of 334. So the inspection team observed that the college was not having the adequate staff strength, the college required twenty two (22) permanent teachers appointed through proper selection committee constituted by University of Jammu as per their intake. The Committee members desired that the faculty working on Adhoc Basis be regularized , provided they fulfill necessary qualification for appointment, as soon as possible.
- 2. The record of last management committee meeting is not available with the college.
- 3. The last Selection Committee Meeting was held in the college in Aug 2012.
- 4. Library facility given by the college to the student was adequate. But the number of books in the library and the amount spent per year for purchasing books was not adequate. There are total of 3038 books in the library. The books were last purchased in April 2010. After that, as per records, there were no purchase.
- 5. Student facilities provided by the college to the students such as Social Activities, Sports, NSS etc. was adequate.
- 6. There are total of 11 computers in the Computer lab. When the team visited the college no computer was having internet facility. Moreover 5 computers were out of order. Besides that there was no AC connection in the computer lab.

12. FINAL RECOMANDATION

The Inspection team recommends that the college be affiliated provisionally for imparting instructions to B.Ed. programme for the academic session 2012-2013 only after obtaining the compliance report from the management and removal of deficiency within a stipulated period.
