OBSERVATIONS /DEFICIENCIES

The New Age College of Education Phinter, Billawar has enrolled 287 students in all for the academic Session 2012-13. The number of students physically counted in different sections of B.Ed were 160 and 20 students were seen in the library of the college.

The number of teachers present in the college were 15 and 4 were on casual leave including Principal of the college. The college has 18 teachers excluding Principal. The college is having well qualified Principal . Out of 18 teachers, six were through selection committee and twelve are on adhoc basis.

The computer lab is well equipped with 20 working computers and two laptops. seven computers has been added in the present session i.e. 2012-13

The total number of books stock is 2392 in the Session 2012-13 as 240 books have been added to existing stock of 2152 present in session 2011-12.

It is suggested that the teachers who have put in two years regular service and have come through proper selection committee may be declared on permanent basis as they have completed probation period.

The deficiency pointed out by earlier visiting team has been met by the institution.
