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

Major Deficiencies need to be attended on priority:

- The Major deficiency ^{is} existed in terms of faculty which ~~has~~ ^{is} persisting since 2014, 2015 & now for 2016.
- time & again The college authorities have been constantly requested written, reminded to fulfil the gap. but no heed has been paid. to the committees visiting the college. CSC office's correspondance in this context. This shows negligence on the part of college where more than 50% faculty has remained on contractual basis since 2014.
- ⇒ In 2014 - The Inspection committee reported 12 teachers on adhoc out of 23.
 - ⇒ In 2015 - The principal was found to be appointed on adhoc basis, which the college can appoint only for 3 months, after which the process of disaffiliation can be initiated.
 - ⇒ In 2016 - The college has only two lecturers on regular basis appointment, rest all staff are contractual.
 - ⇒ Also no mgt committee has been convened since 30/1/2015
 - ⇒ The college has only 2500 books since its opening in 2002.

Minor deficiencies/suggestions:

The college has overlooked the recommendations & suggestions of committees & correspondance is - this began from past 3 yrs & this cannot be allowed to admit students for the current session till it puts required faculty in place.


MAJOR DEFICIENCIES NEED TO BE ATTENDED ON PRIORITY:


- The major persisting deficiency is in terms of faculty since 2014. The college authorities have been requested time and again to fulfill the gap but no heed has been paid. This shows negligence on the part of the college, where more than 50% of faculty has remained on contractual basis since 2014.
- In 2014, the inspection committee reported 12 teachers appointed on contractual basis out of total faculty of 23.
- In 2015, the principal was found to be appointed on adhoc basis, which the college can appoint only for 3 months, as per statutes after which the process of disaffiliation can be initiated against the college.
- In 2016, the college has only 2 teachers on regular basis, rest all staff is contractual.
- Also no management committee has been convened since 30.01.2015.
- The college has only 2500 books since its opening in 2002.


RECOMMENDATIONS:
