OBSERVATIONS / DEFICIENCES

The college has enrolled 314 students (290 open + 24 Mgt. Seats) in the Session 2012-13. There are twenty teachers & one Principal. Out of the 20 teachers, thirteen have been appoint/through proper selection committee constituted by University of Jammu. The Principal though highly qualifited is working on adhoc basis. On the day of inspection i.e. 9th of March, 2013 only 15 teachers were present. Four teachers & Principal of the college were on casual leave.

The physical presence of only 72 students were recorded at the time of inspection at 1.30 pm.

The college has stock of 3715 book as 300 new books have been purchased in this session i.e. 2012-13 to already a stok of 3415 books in the session 2011-12.

The computer lab is equipped with 15 computers only. The Chairman of the college informed that three P.C. have been sent recently to Kathua for their repair. Two computers have been provided with internet connection. The addition of five more computers as recommended by previous Inspection team of 2011-12 has not been compled by the college Management. Hence, it is desired this deficiency may be remove at the earliest by the college.

REMARKS

College authorities be asked to regulate the proper attendance of the students. The college has been accreded as 'B' grade by the National Assessment and Accreditation Council the college may be accorded temporarily affiliation for another year.

Final Recommendations:

The present inspection after examining the records infrastructural facilities, feels that Ramisht College of Education, Basholi District Kathua be granted temporary/provisionally affiliation by the University of Jammu, for the academic Session 2012-13, to run the B.Ed programme subject to the condition that deficiency pointed out by Inspection team will be rectified at the earliest
