11. OBSERVATIONS/DEFICIENCIES

The seat allocation of the College (i) intake=300(excluding Social Infrastructure and Management seats)The appointment of teachers is in proportionate ratio to the students. The last years deficiencies are rectified as the four adhoc teachers who were on adhoc basis and were paid Rs.8000- / are regularized by the selection committee of the university on 22-02-2012. All the permanent teachers are being paid Rs.8000- / plus 50%D.A instead of 25%D.A and yearly increment. The management committee was conducted on 24th September 2011. The college is having a good language lab and computer lab with internet facility.

FINAL RECOMMENDATIONS

After conducting inspection of the College vis-à-vis the prescribed norms, the Committee recommended that J.K College of Education, Jammu be granted extension of temporary/provisional affiliation for imparting instructions in Bachelor's Degree Course in Education (B.Ed.) for the academic session 2012-2013.
