The seat allocation of the College (i) intake=120(excluding Social Infrastructure and Management seats) the previous deficiencies have been rectified according to the norms as for the number of teachers in proportion to the students i.e. twelve teachers (eleven regular and one contractual regarding the salary of the teachers and the principal the matter has been referred to the managing committee. The books have been purchased for Rs.30,000/-and Journals of Rs.6,000/- for the library.

FINAL RECOMMENDATIONS

After conducting inspection of the College vis-à-vis the prescribed norms, the Committee recommended that Sant Mela Singh College of Education, Jammu be granted extension of temporary/provisional affiliation for imparting instructions in Bachelor's Degree Course in Education (B.Ed.) for the academic session 2012-2013. Subject to the condition that the salary of the teachers and principal be approved according to the UGC norms and the books be purchased for the library according to the norms only.
