ACADEMIC AND OTHER ACTIVITIES

OBSERVATIONS / DEFICIENCES

The college has enrolled a total of 303 students (279 in open + 24 mgt. seats) for the academic session 2012-13. The college has 19 faculty members including Principal who is highly qualified (M.Sc, Ph.D). There are 11 permanent teachers & 7 working on adhoc basis. On the day of inspection i.e. 16-3-2012, 15 teachers were present whereas only six students were physically present at 11.30 am. The attendance register of teachers was well maintained but that of students was not properly maintained as roll call of students for previous days were found missing. The absentees students were not marked as A absent for several months. The dates collected from the attendance register and presented in the tabulated form (see Anex.I) shows even on the day of 1st Internal Assessment Test in never exceeded 25%. The library is equipped with 1560 books and 12 Nos of computers in Lab.

The committee asked for the record of endowment fund which was not provided. The earlier inspection team for the academic session 2011-12 had desired that college should add 10 more no. of computers but that was not complied with by the said college.

Final recommendations:

After conducting inspection of the college vis-à-vis the prescribed norms, the committee recommended that Baba Faried College of Education, Hatli Mohrh Kathua be not granted affiliation by the University of Jammu, Jammu to run the B.Ed course till they meet out the deficiency pointed by inspection team of year 2011-12 as well as that of present team.
