The total allocation of seats during the year 2011-12 was 270 including management and supernumerary seats but during the Academic year 2012-13, the college could only fill up 110 seats including the management and supernumerary seats. As per student teacher ratio of 1:15, the college should have 8 teachers including the college Principal but the college has appointed 11 teachers including the college Principal and all are working on permanent basis and are being paid Rs. 12,400/- p.m. The college has a good Computer lab and have added 4 more repaired computers and the total no. of computers were 19 at the time of inspections. However, there is a deficiency one computer as per the last year's compliance report. The college has added more books in the library and the committee members suggested to the college to subscribe more books, journal and magazine relevant to the course for the library.
