**AL MUNI COLLEGE OF EDUCATION (Date of Inspection 29-12-15)**

Observations/Deficiencies/suggestions (if any)

1. Total number of students admitted in the College is 25 as against <sup>70</sup> allotted by the CDC for the year 2015-2016. The College is closed for winter vacations w.e.f. 23<sup>rd</sup> December to 5<sup>th</sup> January as such the number of students present and absent could not be ascertained. However, the committee decided to pay a surprise visit to ascertain the number of students present and absent at a latter date. The Committee will also interact with the students during surprise visit.
2. The Management Committee meeting of the College was held on 31-03-15, copy of the minutes of the Management Committee meeting enclosed.
3. The College has purchased 16 books after the last visit of the Inspection Committee.
4. The Library is well maintained by the College and there are 2772 books in the College library with 386 titles. The Inspecting team suggested that the College should procure some text books by foreign authors for the benefit of the Students.
5. The College has well equipped computer Lab. with audio-visual facility. There were 18 computers in the Lab.
6. The College has a huge building complex and major part of the building is not being utilized due to decrease in number of students admitted in the college during the current academic session 2015-17. Inspection team suggested that the College should start a school as is mandatory according to the guidelines of Verma committee in the premises of the building which is not being utilized and lying vacant.
7. The College has adequate infrastructure, which includes desk, chairs, tables, almirahs, laboratory and other facilities for students as well as staff members. The Inspection Committee suggested that college should construct cabins for the staff of the college and provide internet facilities to them.

**RECOMMENDATIONS OF THE INSPECTION COMMITTEE:**

The Committee recommends that the College be granted temporary affiliation/extension for imparting instruction in B.Ed. for the academic session 2015-17 subject to the condition that chairman of the college submits compliance report for removal of deficiencies pointed out by the inspection team before 31-03-2016.
