Major deficiencies need to be attended on priority:

1. The Inspection Committee observed that there are only four permanent faculty members for B.Ed. course being run by the college selected through a proper Selection Committee. It was found that the college hasn't the subject experts required for compulsory papers to run the B.Ed. course smoothly. A temporary arrangement is made by the college to run the course. It was also found that all the faculty members working in the college are without NET/SET or Ph.D.

However, the college should have more faculty members on permanent basis as per UGC/AICTE norms for running this course smoothly. As we know a teacher has always been vital in the all round personality development of the students. In fact, a teacher is a role model influencing every facet of the student,'s growth and developing their innate potentials, in addition to being a motivator, guide and friend.

- 2. The team observed that the salary to the faculty members is not being paid as per UGC/AICTE norms.
- 3. The college hasn't purchased any text/course related books during the session 2015-16. The inspection team further observed during the interaction with the students and teachers that they are reading and teaching from the small guide books available in the market which are published by Vinod's Publishers, The committee members found that the publisher is using the name of University of Jammu and also mentioned clearly that the books are strictly as per the Syllabus of B.Ed. course being run by University of Jammu.
- 4. It was noticed that the account book and the stock register (i.e. consumable and non-consumable)weren't maintained properly

5. Further observed that the Management Committee meeting was not conducted by the college uptill now

Minor deficiencies/Suggestions:

- 1. The committee has suggested to the representatives of the college that the inspection from NAAC be initiated on priority basis.
- 2. Further suggested that to keep the library update on regular basis in terms of Journals, Magazines, Newspapers etc. and also enlist the book's title/subject wise.
- 3. It was also suggested that a day to day register for issuance of books be maintained in the library.
- 4. The college should have made a list of equipments available in the college used for running this course.

- 2. Further suggested that to keep the library update on regular basis in terms of Journals, Magazines, Newspapers etc. and also enlist the book's title/subject wise.
- 3. It was also suggested that a day to day register for issuance of books be maintained in the library.
- 4. The college should have made a list of equipments available in the college used for running this course.
