11. OBSERVATIONS/DEFICIENCIES

The Inspection Team made the following observations:

1. The adequacy of staff strength vis-a-vis number of students i.e. Teacher: Student Ratio (1:20) was not maintained properly by the college. The college has twenty-one (21) teachers (15 permanent and 6 Adhoc). The college has total seats of 334. So the inspection team observed that the college was not having the adequate staff strength, the college required twenty two (22) permanent teachers appointed through proper selection committee constituted by University of Jammu as per their intake. The Committee members desired that the faculty working on Adhoc Basis be regularized, provided they fulfill necessary qualification for appointment, as soon as possible.

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- 2. The last management committee meeting was held in the college in November 2012.
- 3. The last Selection Committee Meeting was held in the college in July 2012.
- 4. Library facility given by the college to the student was adequate. But the number of books in the library and the amount spent per year for purchasing books was not adequate. There are total of 2415 books in the library. In the year 2012, total of 272 books amounting to Rs. 58,278 were added. The college has also subscribed to 7 journals of NCERT. The library is fully automated.
- 5. Student facilities provided by the college to the students such as Social Activities, Sports, NSS etc. were adequate.
- There are total of 15 computers in the Computer lab having Internet connection with a speed of 100MBPS. In addition to it the college is also having 3 printers, 2 laptops and 1 scanner.

12. FINAL RECOMANDATION

The Inspection team recommends that the college be affiliated provisionally for imparting instructions to B.Ed. programme for the academic session 2012-2013 only after obtaining the compliance report from the management and removal of deficiency within a stipulated period.
