

FINAL RECOMMENDATIONS

After conducting inspection of the College vis-à-vis the prescribed norms, the Committee recommended that Shirdee College of Education, Jammu may be granted extension of temporary/provisional affiliation for imparting instructions in Bachelor's Degree Course in Education (B.Ed.) for the academic session 2011-2012 . The number of the students admitted during the session is 220 (196+24 management seats). There are ten members of teaching faculty eight regular and two on adhoc basis. Out of ten members total one is Principal. Principal is drawing salary of Rs.22700-/=, Five regular teachers are drawing salary of Rs.12600-/= and two regular teachers are getting Rs.10,000-/-each whereas, the one adhoc teacher is getting Rs.8000-/- p.m. There are 1911 books in the library out of which 90 books have been purchased during the session.

The deficiency is indicated in the number of faculty members which is not in required proportion to the total number of students admitted during the session.
