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### **1. OBSERVATIONS/DEFICIENCIES**

The Inspection Team made the following observations:

- 1. The adequacy of staff strength vis-a-vis number of students i.e. Teacher: Student Ratio (1:15) was not maintained properly by the college. The college has a qualified Principal appointed through proper selection committee constituted by University of Jammu. The college has Fifteen (15) permanent teachers. The college has capacity of 300 intake and the total seats of the college are 334. So the inspection team observed that the college was not having the adequate staff strength, the college required twenty two (22) permanent teachers appointed through proper selection committee constituted by University of Jammu as per their intake. The team also observed that the salary given to the staff of the college was not as per norms.
- 2. No record was available for management committee meetings.
- 3. Library facility given by the college to the student was adequate. But the number of books in the library and the amount spent per year for purchasing books was not adequate. The B.Ed. College has shared the library space with the library of Degree College and ETT College. Records were not maintained for no. of books, journals, Magazines etc. available in the library. And also the subscription of journals, Magazines etc. was irregular.
- 4. Student facilities provided by the college to the students such as Social Activities, Sports, NSS etc. was adequate.
- 5. The Inspection Team found ambiguity in the office records like personal files of the staff, stock register, salary register etc.

#### **12. FINAL RECOMANDATION**

The Inspection team recommends that the college be affiliated provisionally for imparting instructions to B.Ed. programme for the academic session 2012-2013 only after obtaining the compliance report from the management and removal of deficiency within a stipulated period.
