11. OBSERVATIONS/DEFICIENCIES

1. The seat allocation of the College is - (i) intake = 300 Management = 24 seats, supernumerary seats = 10 (five each for the University and the College) meaning thereby the college was having 334 seats in the academic session 2011-12. As per student teacher ratio of 1:15 the college should have 20 permanent faculty members.
2. The college is having 18 faculty members out of which 11 faculty members have been appointed by the Statutory Selection Committee on permanent basis and the remaining 07 faculty members have been appointed by the Management on adhoc / part time basis. It was observed that 02 faculty members appointed on part time basis are paid Rs.4,500/- only and the same is in contradiction to the University directions in this regard.
3. The inspection committee directed the management to regularize the adhoc / part time faculty members at the earliest through Statutory Selection Committee.
4. Out of 269 students, only 65 students were present in the College. The inspection committee directed the management to issue notices to the non attending candidates.
5. The college added books amounting to Rs.35,000/- in the Library. The inspection committee desired that a minimum of Rs.50,000/- should be spent on purchase of books ever year.

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FINAL RECOMMENDATIONS

After conducting inspection of the College vis-à-vis the prescribed norms, the Committee recommended that N.S.M. College of Education, Jammu be granted extension of temporary/provisional affiliation for imparting instructions in Bachelor's Degree Course in Education (B.Ed.) for the academic session 2012-13 subject to the condition that the Chairman of the college shall submit compliance report for removal of deficiencies pointed out by the Inspection team within one month from the date of issuance of inspection report.
