

OBSERVATIONS/DEFICIENCIES/SUGESSTIONS (IF ANY):

The committee members inspected the college and found that the college has good infrastructure and other facilities like play ground, Library, Laboratories (Science and Computers), indoor games, Psychology Lab, Audio Visual Aids Room, and Conference /Seminar Hall for the B.Ed students.

The Committee pointed out following deficiencies on the inspection of the college:





1. The college has not conducted Selection Committee meeting since 2005, and has only four teachers working (excluding Principal) on permanent basis. The committee asked the Principal to regularize the staff through selection committee within two months time period as it was a persisting deficiency of the college.
2. The college has been accredited by NAAC with CGPA of 2.48 as "B" Grade.
3. The last Management Committee meeting was held in 2012. The Committee asked the college to conduct the meetings more frequently (twice a year, as per statutes) to discuss administrative issues.
4. The Committee observed that no teacher has attended any Refresher/ Orientation Course in recent past. The committee suggested that the Principal should send two teachers rotation wise to attend such courses as these courses add up to the self confidence of the faculty and gives them recognition like the main stream Govt. Teachers.
5. The Committee also asked the Principal to discuss the issue of proportionate increase in salary of the staff (both Teaching and Non Teaching) in the Management Committee Meeting. The Committee believes that the staff working in the college, since long, need some incentive apart from usual increment due, for carrying on the hard work; especially those having dual/ higher qualifications.
6. No seminar (education related topics) or extension lectures were arranged by the college in the last session. The Committee suggested that each subject teacher should be made Incharge of conducting one seminar or extension lecture in his/her concerned subject by arranging or inviting the resource person.
7. The Committee proposed that separate budgetary provision should be allocated for infrastructure development, library/lab, FDPs and research related activities at the start of the session.
8. The Committee asked the management to add low cost teaching aids made by the students in the teaching aids room, also Prof. Darshana suggested some Journals, Commission Reports, which may also help the college staff and students with research related activities.

FINAL RECOMENDATIONS OF THE INSPECTION COMMITTEE:

The Committee, therefore, recommends the grant of temporary affiliation in favour of N.S.M College of Education for the academic session 2014-2015 subject to the condition that the Chairman of the college shall give a compliance report on removal of the deficiencies pointed out by the inspection team as indicated in the inspection report, and remove the deficiencies w.r.t point number 10.1 and 10.3 before the start of next session.
