OBSERVATIONS/DEFICIENCIES/SUGESSTIONS (IF ANY):

The committee members inspected the college and found that the college has good infrastructure and other facilities like classrooms, library, Conference /Seminar Hall, laboratory, parking space, for the B.Ed students.

The Committee pointed out following deficiencies on the inspection of the college:

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- 1. The committee observed that the college has recently convened its selection committee meeting and has 11 regular lecturers, only 3 are working on adhoc basis, the management committee meeting has also been recently held which is as per norms and a healthy practice.
- 2. The college has initiated a step of faculty exchange among various B.ed colleges, which is a good step and can benefit colleges with experienced and trained faculty also this can mitigate the requirement of lecturers for colleges who have deficient faculty.
- 3. The committee observed that the college conducted a national seminar and various co curricular activities like quiz competition, slogan writing, workshop on teaching aids, extension lectures etc in the previous session.
- 4. The Committee observed that very few teachers have attended Refresher/ Orientation Course in past. The committee suggested that the Principal should send two teachers rotation wise to attend such courses as these courses add up to the self confidence of the faculty and gives them recognition like the main stream Govt. Teachers.
- 5. The Committee observed that the salary of the employees is still being given through cheques, the committee directed the management to divert the salary directly to the bank account of the employed faculty. Also it was seen that some of the faculty were being paid 8000/- even after their selection through selection committee, which was not as per norms. The committee asked the management to increase their salary and pay atleast 12,000/- p.m plus annual increments regularly.
- 6. The Committee proposed that separate budgetary provision should be allocated for library/lab, FDPs and research related activities at the start of the session.
- 7. The committee observed that the maintenance of attendance of the students is a problem for the college, thus the committee advised that shortages should be calculated and displayed monthly and activities of the college be charted out before the start of session so as to keep the student engaged throughout the year.

FINAL RECOMENDATIONS OF THE INSPECTION COMMITTEE:

The Committee, therefore, recommends the grant of temporary affiliation in favour of Ranjit College of Education for the academic session 2014-2015 subject to the condition that the Chairman of the college shall remove the deficiencies pointed out by the inspection team as indicated in the inspection report w.r.t point numbers 5,6,7 before the start of next session and point number 4 in the next session.
