# 11. OBSERVATIONS/DEFICIENCIES

1. The seat allocation of the College is – (i) intake = 270 Management = 22 seats, supernumerary seats = 10 (five each for the University and the College) meaning thereby the college was having 302 seats in the academic session 2011-12. As per student teacher ratio of 1:15 the college should have 18 permanent faculty members.

2. The last selection committee was held in March-2011. The inspection committee directed the management to select the Principal/ Teaching faculty

through University Selection Committee.

3. The library of the college has subscribed various journals but the current issues of the same were not available in the library. Moreover, books pertaining to the course of ETT were kept in the library and the management could not give any logical reason for the same.

4. The computer lab is in very bad shape and is not being maintained properly. Most of the computers are outdated / obsolete and out of 13 machines, only 08 are in working order. No printer is available in the computer lab. and there is

no internet connectivity available in the computer lab.

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5. The management of the college still disburses salary through Account Payees Cheques and the same is in contradiction to the guidelines issued by the University. The management of the college was asked to stop this practice immediately and disburse the salary in the Bank Accounts of the faculty members.

# FINAL RECOMMENDATIONS

After conducting inspection of the College vis-à-vis the prescribed norms, the Committee recommended that Tagore College of Education, Akalpur (Lower Muthi) Jammu be granted extension of temporary/provisional affiliation for imparting instructions in Bachelor's Degree Course in Education (B.Ed.) for the academic session 2012-13 subject to the condition that the Chairman of the college shall submit compliance report for removal of deficiencies pointed out by the Inspection team within one month from the date of issuance of inspection report to the college.
