## 10. ACADEMIC AND OTHER ACTIVITIES

The Inspection Committee members could not interact with the students admitted in the college since the Principal/Management of the college had declared vacations for 10 days to the students at their own in violation of University Academic Calendar.

## 11. OBSERVATIONS/DEFICIENCES

The seats allocation of the College for the Academic year 2011-12 were 302 including the Management seats and supernumerary seats including the University seats. But during the Academic session 2012-13, the college could only admit 246 candidates to the B.Ed. course including the management seats and University seats. As per the standard students-teacher ratio of $1: 15$, the college has appointed 18 faculty members including the Principal of the College on permanent basis duly appointed by the Statutory Selection Committee constituted by the University. The college has added 1484 books which have been accessioned properly. In addition, the college has a well equipped Library and Computer lab with internet facility in place. The committee desired that some relevant magazine and journals be also subscribed for the library while taking a serious view of the absence of students, the committee members directed the management to maintain punctuality of the students.

## FINAL RECOMMENDATIONS

After conducting inspection of the College vis-à-vis the prescribed norms, the Committee recommended that Hill People's College of Education, near Kangar Mort, Kot Bhalwal, Jammu may be granted extension of temporary/provisional affiliation for imparting instruction in Bachelor's Degree session 2012-13 subject to compliance report for moral of deficiencies pointed out by the Inspection team before the start of the session.
