OBSERVATIONS/DEFICIENCIES/SUGESSTIONS (IF ANY):

The Committee pointed out following deficiencies on the inspection of the college:

1. The committee observed that the college has 7 regular lecturers, while 7 are working on adhoc basis, the management committee meeting has also been recently held. The college has a permanent principal. The last selection committee was held in 2012, the principal assured the team that the same would be conducted in current year as well.

- 2. The committee noticed that the college has conducted various co curricular activities but no seminar or conference was conducted in the previous section. Also no guest lectures from College or Universities were organized.
- 3. The Committee observed that the library have 7011 books but only two book have been added in last session there are no e-journals subscribed by the college. The library is not automated, it has lot many books but Good/ Quality reference books are absent.
- 4. The Committee observed that the salary of the employees is still being given through cheques; the committee directed the management to divert the salary directly to the bank account of the employed faculty. The committee asked the management to pay annual increments regularly. Increments were being given without following any guideline. The committee felt there is a strong need to revise salary and follow the norms in paying increments.
- 5. The Committee proposed that separate budgetary provision should be allocated for library/lab, FDPs and research related activities at the start of the session.
- 6. The committee observed though the college was showing growth in terms of infrastructure and other amenities, the human resource development was lacking, discontent with regard to salary was visible. Teachers working in the college since so many years and also those with higher qualification were treated alike as new recruited. The committee suggested that the management should give incentives and recognition to those teachers who are associated with teaching of their college since a long time.

FINAL RECOMENDATIONS OF THE INSPECTION COMMITTEE:

The Committee, therefore, recommends the grant of temporary affiliation in favour of Hill People College of Education for the academic session 2014-2015 subject to the condition that the Chairman of the college shall remove the deficiencies pointed out by the inspection team as indicated in the inspection report w.r.t point numbers 1,4,5,and 6 before the start of next session while remaining deficiencies be complied with during the ensuing session.
