OBSERVATIONS/DEFICIENCIES/SUGESSTIONS (IF ANY):

The committee members observed a careless attitude on the part of college management, as the record was not properly shown/ maintained for inspection. The committee members observed stagnation with respect to the growth of the academics of the college. No addition in infrastructure, books, journals, academic activity, faculty development initiatives was seen in the last two years.

The committee pointed out following deficiencies on the inspection of the college:

1. The college has only three permanent lecturers and one contractual lecturer to teach the compulsory subjects, the principal is included in the teaching programme in addition to managing the administrative affairs of the college. The committee advised that selection committee meeting should be called on priority to regularise the staff.
2. The college has no qualified faculty for teaching of English and Hindi. The subjects are being taught by ineligible temporary arrangements. The college is required to provide teachers for all teaching subjects as are opted by the students.
3. No seminar (education related topics) or extension lectures were arranged by the college in the last session. The power point presentation was made but no effort to present it before the inspection committee was done by the principal.
4. The Committee found that there was no addition in the number of books for the library in the last two years. Neither the college has subscribed any journal for the students. The committee enlisted this as a serious deficiency on the part of the management. The committee asked the principal to keep separate budgetary provisions for purchase of books and infrastructure development.
5. The librarian of the college is also appointed on contractual basis. The committee advised that she should also be regularized through selection committee meeting.
6. No management committee meeting has been held in recent past, the principal was apprised of the rule that atleast two such meetings were necessary in an academic session.
7. Only 10 students out of total of 43 students admitted to the education programme were present on the day of inspection.
8. There has been no participation of the faculty of the college in any refresher or orientation course for updating their knowledge and in turn contributing to the education system.
9. The Committee pointed out that the college has no Audio Visual Aids Room, Teaching Aids Room, and Language Lab for teaching communicative skills.
10. The teaching staff of the college is not being paid annual increments as per the scheduled rates. The reason cited for the lapse on the part of the management was inadequate student strength and hence financial restraint. The committee however did not approve of such irregularity.





FINAL RECOMENDATIONS OF THE INSPECTION COMMITTEE:

The Committee after making the necessary inspection recommends that the extension to the temporary/ provisional affiliation for the session 2014-15 be given

only after the above deficiencies are removed and a re-inspection is carried out to check the compliance with respect to points number 1,2,4,5 and 10.

In case the college fails to comply with the above mentioned conditions, The committee proposes that the admission for the session 2015-16 be not made unless the college removes all deficiencies and raises its standard of teaching.
