OBSERVATIONS/DEFICIENCIES

The inspection committee was received by the Principal and other faculty members of the College. The committee members were apprised about the activities of the institute by giving power point presentation in the Principal's office. A hard copy of the power-point presentation is given at annexure attached with the report. Thereafter the Principal accompanied the committee members towards the library and class-rooms of the College. The members visited the computer labs, class-rooms, library and interacted with the faculty. Because of breaks, no student was there either in the Hostel or in the College.

The inspection committee also perused the last inspection report of the said College and noted that it was advised by the last inspection team to regularize the faculty working on adhoc basis at an earliest. Further the annual increment to the permanent faculty members be released periodically. The committee noted that the college has taken steps for getting the regularization of adhoc staff by requesting the University selection committee members to give suitable time for the conduct of interviews and as per assurance of the Principal, the selection committee meeting will be conducted in the month of January, 2013. As regards, release of increment the matter is being placed in the management committee meeting at its next meeting as informed by the Principal of the College. The committee also noted that the college has adequate number of books in the Library. Attendance of the students and the faculty pertaining to the academic session 2011-12 was also seen by the inspection team and found the same in order. The Committee members were informed that this year only 201 students sought admission in the college against 334 seats. There were 16 faculty members including the Principal out of which seven are on permanent basis and rest are contractual.

RECOMMENDATIONS

After conducting inspection of the College vis-à-vis the prescribed norms, the Committee observed that the College has adequate infrastructure, faculty and other required facilities for imparting instructions to B.Ed. programme. The committee, therefore, recommends grant of extension of temporary affiliation to Durga College of Education for Women, Katra with the existing intake for the academic session 2012-13 subject to the condition that the Chairman of the Institute shall give an undertaking on the stamped paper of proper value that he shall remove the deficiencies with regard to appointment of faculty through University Selection Committee and release of increments to the permanent staff before the start of the admissions for the next session.
