A copy of the inspection report is enclosed herewith for information and necessary action at your end.



Report of the Inspection Committee for the inspection of
Vivekananda College of Education, Lakhanpur for extension of
temporary affiliation for the session 2016-17
Date of inspection 09.08.2016

1. Inspection Committee visited Vivekananda College of Education, Lakhanpur on 09.08.2016 for conducting the Annual Inspection of the college.
2. The committee observed that salary of the faculty members has not been paid as per UGC/AICTE norms as was also pointed out by the previous committee. The committee was, however, informed that discussion and meeting are being held between Principal and Chairman for upgrading the salaries as per UGC/AICTE norms. Moreover, college is deducting the CPF/EPF of its employees and a proper register is being maintained in this regard.
3. The college has not purchased valid/licensed software to be used in the Computers of the college. It was, however, insisted that licensed software should be used for the computers of the college.
4. As far as exit policy is concerned, it was informed that prior information is provided by the faculty members who exit the job. Few of the employees/faculty members have left because of their selection in Govt. jobs. While few other female members resigned because of their marriage in other states or due to other domestic problems.
5. Books of the Account have not been maintained properly.
6. Approach road from NH to college is not in good condition. The Principal of the college informed that concerned authorities have been approached in this regard.

Minor deficiencies/Suggestion

1. The committee suggested that library of the college be updated and more newspapers and journals be subscribed.
2. Account book should be maintained properly.

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Recommendations of the Inspection Committee

In view of the above observations, the committee recommends that Vivekananda College of Education, Lakhanpur be granted temporary affiliation for imparting instructions in B.Ed. for the session 2016-17 subject to the fulfillment of the deficiencies on pointed out by the Inspection Committee.
