10. ACADEMIC AND OTHER ACTIVITIES

While inspecting the college, the members of the committee observed that only 10 students were attending the class work that two without their Identity cards. The majority of teachers were on contractual basis and were not appointed through the Statutory Selection Committee constituted by the University for the purpose.

11. OBSERVATIONS/DEFICIENCIES

The seats allocation of the college was 302 including Management and supernumerary seats but the college could only admit 262 seats including Management and other allocated seats. As per student teacher ratio of 1:15, the total teachers required were about 18 and the college is having a faculty of 19 members including one Principal. 11 teachers were appointed on permanent basis and 8 on contractual basis and the Committee desired that the remaining 8 contractual teachers be also made permanent after conducting the interviews by the duly constituted statutory Selection Committee approved by the University. The Committee Members desired that the faculty working on adhoc basis be regularized at the earliest. It was further noticed that all the permanent faculty members have been paid salary @ Rs.12,000/- per month whereas the adhoc teachers have been paid salary @ Rs. 8,000/- per month. The college is giving annual increment to the permanent teachers. The college is having a collection of 1815 books in the library. The college has added more books during the last session. The committee members suggested to the college to subscribe more books, journal and magazine relevant to the course for the library. It was noticed that no Selection Committee meeting and Management Committee meeting has not yet been held during the last session. The college is having a well equipped Computer Lab having 25 computers with internet facility.
