11. **OBSERVATIONS/DEFICIENCIES**

- 1. The seat allocation of the College is (i) intake = 300 Management = 24 seats, supernumerary seats = 10 (five each for the University and the College) meaning thereby the college was having 334 seats in the academic session 2011-12. As per student teacher ratio of 1:15 the college should have 20 permanent faculty members.
- 2. Presently, the college is having 14 faculty members out of which 10 faculty members have been appointed by the Statutory Selection Committee on permanent basis and the remaining 04 faculty members have been appointed by the Management on adhoc basis. The inspection committee directed the management to appoint all the faculty members through University Selection Committee.
- 3. For the current session, the college has a total of 244 candidates including management quota and on the day of inspection, 95 candidates were present.
- 4. The committee asked the management to encourage the faculty to participate in Refresher/Orientation Courses.

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FINAL RECOMMENDATIONS

After conducting inspection of the College vis-à-vis the prescribed norms, the Committee recommended that Handa College of Education, Sainik Colony, Jammu be granted extension of temporary/provisional affiliation for imparting instructions in Bachelor's Degree Course in Education (B.Ed.) for the academic session 2012-13 subject to the condition that the Chairman of the college shall submit compliance report for removal of deficiencies pointed out by the Inspection team within one month from the date of issuance of inspection report to the college.
