11. OBSERVATIONS/DEFICIENCIES

- 1. The college has a total of 14 faculty members whereas the sanctioned intake of the college is 300 and the current admission is 166 candidates including management. As per student teacher ratio of 1:15 the college should have 20 permanent faculty members.
- 2. Only 35 students were present on the day of inspection.
- 3. For the session 2011-12, college purchased the books amounting to Rs.41,000/- which was less than the desired amount of Rs.50,000/-. Moreover, for the academic session 2011-12, the books were purchased on 03.04.2012, the committee directed the college to purchase the books well in time.
- 4. There are 15 Computers in Computer Lab. and 12 are in working order. The inspection committee desired that computer lab should have minimum of 20 computers.
- 5. Though college has conducted selection committee recently but still four faculty members are on adhoc basis. The committee directed the management to conduct interviews for the same through University Selection Committee.
- 6. The committee asked the management to encourage the faculty to participate in Refresher/Orientation Courses.

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FINAL RECOMMENDATIONS

After conducting inspection of the College vis-à-vis the prescribed norms, the Committee recommended that Taawish College of Education, Channi Rama, Jammu be granted extension of temporary/provisional affiliation for imparting instructions in Bachelor's Degree Course in Education (B.Ed.) for the academic session 2012-13 subject to the condition that the Chairman of the college shall submit compliance report for removal of deficiencies pointed out by the Inspection team within one month from the issuance of inspection report to the college.
