OBSERVATIONS/DEFICIENCIES/SUGESSTIONS (IF ANY):

The committee members on inspection of the college observed that the college was affected badly by the flood water that has ruined the wall, gate of the college and adjoining road to the college is completely eroded.

The committee pointed out following observations/deficiencies on the physical inspection of the college:

1. The college has appointed seven permanent lecturers and two contractual lecturer to teach the B. Ed course, however as per the new statutes only four teachers meet the eligibility for teaching the new syllabus. There is no principal; however the senior most lecturer is presently holding the charge for the time being. The chairperson of the college apprised the members that the advertisement for the posts has already been published in the





newspapers on 25th July 2015 and the interviews would be conducted soon.

2. The Committee found that there is less addition in the number of books for the library, however the college has sufficient number of books and has subscribed for journals and magazines required as per norms. Also, as per the chairperson, the syllabus was expected to change from session 2015-16, so the college did not order for more books.
3. No management committee meeting has been held in recent past, the principal was apprised of the rule that atleast two such meetings were necessary in an academic session.
4. The teaching staff of the college is not being paid annual increments as per the scheduled rates. The reason cited for the lapse on the part of the management was inadequate student strength and hence financial restraint.
5. No seminar or extension lectures have been arranged by the college in the last session. The committee asked the management to ensure that the said activity is carried out in ensuing session.

FINAL RECOMENDATIONS OF THE INSPECTION COMMITTEE:

The Committee after making the necessary inspection recommends that the extension to the temporary/ provisional affiliation for the session 2014-15 be given in favour of Taawish College of Education and further college be asked to submit compliance report with respect to selection committee and management committee within one month from issue of the report.
