11. OBSERVATIONS/DEFICIENCIES

- 1. The seat allocation of the College is (i) intake = 300 Management = 24 seats, supernumerary seats = 10 (five each for the University and the College) meaning thereby the college was having 334 seats in the academic session 2011-12. As per student teacher ratio of 1:15 the college should have 20 permanent faculty members.
- 2. The college has a total of 18 faculty members out of which 08 are on adhoc basis. The inspection committee directed the management to fill the teaching positions through University Selection Committee.
- Presently, the college has a total of 244 candidates and on the day of inspection, only 35 candidates were present in the college.
- 4. The current issues of journals subscribed by the college are not available and indeed the older copies are displayed in the library.
- 5. The computer lab of the college is situated in other building which was earlier being used as BBA/BCA college. The inspection committee directed the management to shift the computer lab in B.Ed. College building.
- 6. The committee asked the management to encourage the faculty to participate in Refresher/Orientation Courses.

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FINAL RECOMMENDATIONS

After conducting inspection of the College vis-à-vis the prescribed norms, the Committee recommended that Galaxy College of Education, Sainik Colony, Jammu be granted extension of temporary/provisional affiliation for imparting instructions in Bachelor's Degree Course in Education (B.Ed.) for the academic session 2012-13 subject to the condition that the Chairman of the college shall submit compliance report for removal of deficiencies pointed out by the Inspection team within one month from the date of issuance of inspection report to the college.
