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### 11. **OBSERVATIONS/DEFICIENCIES**

- 1. The seat allocation of the College is (i) intake = 230 Management = 18 seats, supernumerary seats = 10 (five each for the University and the College) meaning thereby the college was having 258 seats in the academic session 2012-13. As per student teacher ratio of 1:15 the college should have 17 permanent faculty members. However, the college has twelve faculty members in all. The inspection committee desired that all the faculty members should be regularized through University Approved Selection Committee and College should also regularize the appointment of Principal at the earliest.
- 2. The faculty engaged for ICT is not eligible and eligible faculty should be appointed at the earliest.
- 3. The inspection committee observed that there is no librarian in the college and desired that eligible librarian be appointed at the earliest.
- 4. The inspection committee desired that college should appoint eligible faculty for the subject Mathematics at the earliest.
- 5. The inspection committee appreciated the practice of deducting Provident Fund by the college and observed that matching share is contributed by the college

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management. The inspection committee recommends that this practice may be followed in all private affiliated colleges of University.

### FINAL RECOMMENDATIONS

After conducting inspection of the College vis-à-vis the prescribed norms, the Committee recommended that Bharat College of Education, Hatli Morh, Kathua be granted extension of temporary/provisional affiliation for imparting instructions in Bachelor's Degree Course in Education (B.Ed.) for the academic session 2012-13 subject to the condition that the Chairman of the College shall submit compliance report for removal of deficiencies pointed out by the Inspection team before 15<sup>th</sup> January, 2013.
