The following deficiencies have been pointed out by the inspection committee and I have taken care of the deficiencies. I hereby submit the compliance with measures taken on the deficiencies pointed out by the inspection committee as under: -

1.The strength of faculty member is inadequate as per teacher – student ratio(1:15).	The College has appointed adequate 12 faculty members against the students admitted strength of 172 for the session 2014-15.However to appoint more faculty members the vacancies have been advertised in the newspaper dated 07-02-2015. (Copy Enclosed)
2. The College has appointed the Principal without constitution of the Selection committee.	The College has approached the Director CDC,University of Jammu for constitution of Selection Committee vide Letter No.BCE/2014-15/882 dated 24-01-2015.
3.Increase No.of Library Books.	Then College has adequate No. of Library books for the present strength of students. However the books will be purchased before start of next session.
4. There is no Librarian.	The vacancy has been advertised in the newspaper dated 07-02-2015.(Copy Enclosed).
5. Engage eligible candidate to teach English.	The vacancy has been advertised in the newspaper dated 07-02-2015.(Copy Enclosed).



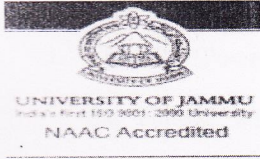

OBSERVATIONS/DEFICIENCIES/SUGESSTIONS:

1. The PPT (Power Point Presentation) was not made as there was no responsible person from the college administration/Management to have undertaken the responsibility of the Presentation.
2. As per the Teacher-Student ratio (1:15) is inadequate as the college has only ten faculty members (eight permanent and two on adhoc basis). The college should have 12 permanent faculty members against the admitted student strength of 172 for the session 2014-15.
3. The Principal of the College has not been selected through proper Selection Committee as evident from the available records. Moreover, it is recorded with ample magnitude of strangeness that the earlier principal remaining absent from duty for nearly one and half years, the college chose to appoint his replacement on 08-01-2015(a day before the University inspection was scheduled) and that too without following any prescribed procedure.
4. The Inspection committee members observed that the salary to the faculty members is not being paid as per UGC/AICTE norms.
5. The number of students present in total including all the three sections is 104 against an admitted strength of 172. This is a situation regarding the number of students attending the college on a day when the University team visiting the college is notified in advance.
6. The college is said to have purchased books worth Rs. 52,863/- during the 2012. The same observation was pointed out by the earlier Inspection Committee. However, no bills are available with the college for this purchase. During the last two years, no book purchase has been realized.
7. The Inspection Committee observed that there is no Librarian in the college and desired that an eligible Librarian be appointed at the earliest.


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8. The Inspection Committee desired that the college should appoint eligible faculty for the subject English through proper selection committee.
9. The Committee finds the students attendance as being fabricated because there is 100% attendance shown for the past few months while on the day of inspection only 104 students were reportedly present against the admitted strength of 172 students for the session 2014-15. The Committee has confiscated the Attendance Register of the students. (The attendance register (01) is being submitted to the office of the CDC, University of Jammu along with the report).


FINAL RECOMENDATIONS OF THE INSPECTION COMMITTEE:


After conducting the inspection of the college vis-à-vis the prescribed norms, the committee recommended that the college be granted extension of temporary/provisional affiliation for imparting instructions in Bachelor's Degree Course in Education (B.Ed.) for the academic session 2014-15 subject to the condition that the Chairman of the college shall submit compliance report for removal of deficiencies pointed out by the Inspection team.


