11. **OBSERVATIONS/DEFICIENCIES**

1. The seat allocation of the College is – (i) intake = 240 Management = 19 seats, supernumerary seats = 10 (five each for the University and the College) meaning thereby the college was having 269 seats in the academic session 2011-12. As per student teacher ratio of 1:15 the college should have 16 permanent faculty members.
2. The college has 15 faculty members, out of which 11 are permanent and 04 are on adhoc basis. The inspection committee directed the management to select all the teaching faculty through University Selection Committee.
3. It was noticed by the inspection committee that no pay is given to the faculty members in case of Maternity Leave. The inspection committee directed the management to stop this practice and desired that maternity leave should be sanctioned alongwith pay.
4. The committee asked the management to encourage the faculty to participate in Refresher/Orientation Courses.


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### FINAL RECOMMENDATIONS




