11. OBSERVATIONS/DEFICIENCIES

- 1. The seat allocation of the College is (i) intake = 180 Management = 14 seats, supernumerary seats = 10 (five each for the University and the College) meaning thereby the college was having 204 seats in the academic session 2012-13. As per student teacher ratio of 1:15 the college should have 13 permanent faculty members. The college has not regularized the appointment of faculty members through University Approved Selection Committee and the same was pointed out by last inspection committee also. The inspection committee desired that college should regularize the appointment of faculty latest by 15th January, 2013.
- 2. There is no faculty for the subject of EVS.
- 3. The college has not conducted the management committee for the last three years and the inspection committee desired that the same be conducted at the earliest.
- 4. The college needs to maintain a Cash Book on regular basis.

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- 5. For the academic session 2011-12, the college had purchased the books amounting to Rs.47,648/- which was less than the stipulated amount of Rs.50.000/-.
- 6. The college should make efforts for better internet connectivity in the college.
- 7. The approach road to the college is in very bad shape and college management should make efforts to improve the same.
- 8. The college has not held any selection committee meeting even after being pointed out by the last Inspection Committee for which college had also given the undertaking for doing the needful.

FINAL RECOMMENDATIONS

After conducting inspection of the College vis-à-vis the prescribed norms, the Committee recommended that Sri Sri Parmahansa Yogananda College of Education, Jagatpur, Kathua be granted extension of temporary/provisional affiliation for imparting instructions in Bachelor's Degree Course in Education (B.Ed.) for the academic session 2012-13 subject to the condition with that the Chairman of the college shall submit compliance report for removal of deficiencies pointed out by the Inspection team before 15th January, 2013.
