
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


Observations/Deficiencies/Suggestions (if any)

1. The total number of students admitted in the college is 89 during the session 2014-15, out of which 61 students were present on the day of inspection i.e. on 02-02-2015. As per teacher-student ratio of 1:15, the college has eight teachers out of which 04 have been appointed by the selection committee and the rest of the teachers were appointed by the Management Committee on contractual basis.
2. The college has not conducted any Management Committee meeting during the session 2014-15. The Inspection team asked the college to conduct Management Committee meeting within the remaining period of the session.
3. The college has neither shown the cash book nor the bills for the purchase of books as the college has purchased the books amounting to Rs 78135/- as reflected in the inspection report by the college during the last two years. List of library books was not displayed/provided.
4. The approach road to the college is in dilapidated condition. The college administration must make efforts to get it repaired.
5. At the time of inspection, no librarian was present. The library was managed by a Physical Education Teacher, which should be avoided.
6. Books were not properly maintained and the pages of some books were torn.
7. The college has no hostel facility.
8. The college has a huge building and a major part of it is not utilized due to decrease in number of students in the current session. The building also needs proper maintenance and care.
