11. **OBSERVATIONS/DEFICIENCIES**

- 1. The seat allocation of the College is (i) intake = 300 Management = 24 seats, supernumerary seats = 10 (five each for the University and the College) meaning thereby the college was having 334 seats in the academic session 2012-13. As per student teacher ratio of 1:15 the college should have 22 permanent faculty members. Since the college has filled 300 seats the total faculty members should be 20 instead of 18.
- 2. The college has not conducted the selection committee for appointment of faculty and the same was pointed out during the last year inspection also.
- 3. The inspection committee desired that college should organize programmes for faculty improvement and teaching faculty should be encouraged to attend Orientation, Refresher Courses.

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FINAL RECOMMENDATIONS

After conducting inspection of the College vis-à-vis the prescribed norms, the Committee recommended that Dogra College of Education, Bassi Kalan, Bari Brahmana, Jammu be granted extension of temporary/provisional affiliation for imparting instructions in Bachelor's Degree Course in Education (B.Ed.) for the academic session 2012-13 subject to the condition that the Chairman of the college shall submit compliance report for removal of deficiencies pointed out by the Inspection team within one month from the date of issuance of inspection report to the college.

- 1. The Principal of the College was not present on the date of inspection and the same was pointed out in the last year's inspection report also.
- 2. As per College Management, there are only 05 permanent teachers and rest of the faculty members are contractuals.
- 3. No record pertaining to last selection committee, salary disbursement and management committee was made available to the inspection committee and the record (if available) had glaring discrepancies.
- 4. The faculty members are still paid salary through cash and the same is in contradiction to the University policy.
- 5. The college does not have a librarian and the college has not purchased books / journals for the academic session.
- 6. Only 21 candidates were present on the day of inspection.

FINAL RECOMMENDATIONS

After conducting inspection of the College vis-à-vis the prescribed norms, the inspection Committee does not recommend extension of temporary/provisional affiliation for imparting instructions in Bachelor's Degree Course in Education (B.Ed.) in favour of Divya College of Education, Lower Gaddi Garh, Miran Sahib, Jammu for the academic session 2012-13 and the candidates allotted to the college may be shifted to some other college as per the University norms.
