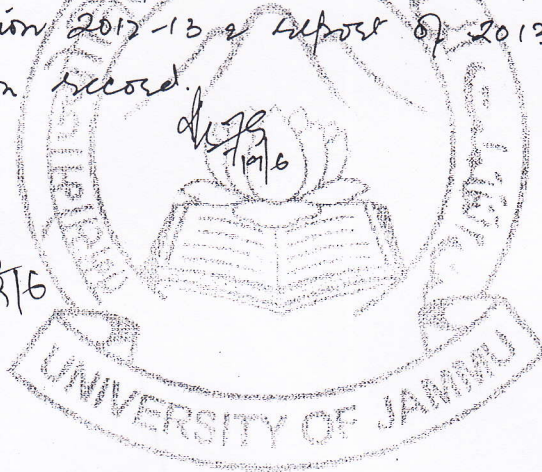

Law College for academic year 2013-14 was fixed on 28.08.2013 at 11.00 a.m. vide letter No. CDC/2013/3524-26 dated 16.08.2013 and later on postponed vide letter No. CDC/2013/4026-30 dated 26.08.2013 (Copies enclosed) due to non-availability of other members of inspection team.

It may be mentioned here that when the date of the inspection of the above said college was fixed, the then A.R. (CDC) now A.R. (Accounts) who was also the member secretary of the inspection team was verbally informed about the schedule to conduct the inspection of the college. But in response to the same, the concerned officer had intimated that he had already conducted the inspection of the above said college and the report was lying in the desktop of his previous computer which was installed in A.R. (CDC) room and during the search of the said computer, the inspection report was not traceable. The concerned officer was, thereafter, again contacted and asked about the inspection report and in response to the same he sent a written message to A.R. (CDC) ~~and~~ intimating that the said inspection report is available on the desktop which he had left after relieving from the office of CDC. Not only this, the concerned college was also asked about the same that whether the college was inspected or not. In response to the same, the Principal of the College had intimated that the college was not inspected for the session 2013-14 by any of the members of the University till date.

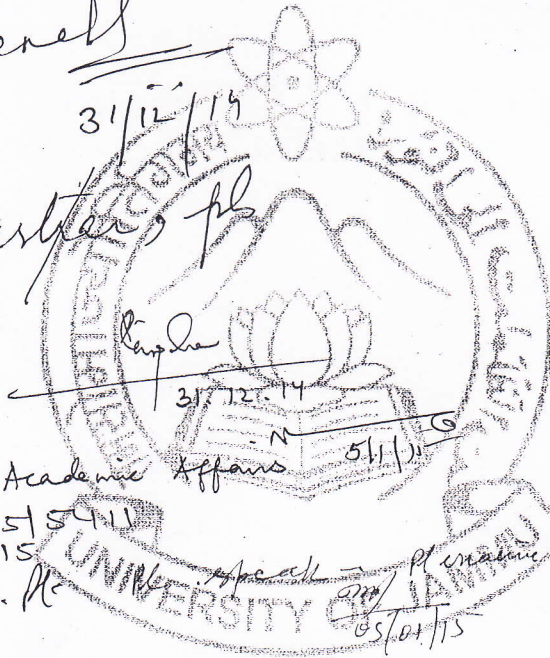

According to amended statutes governing affiliation of Colleges and other Institutions wherein statute 12-A pertains to grant of temporary affiliation of the colleges vide notification No. 5 of 2014 dated 15.01.2014 under endorsement No. Coord./Statutes/14/2220-4539 dated 15.01.2014 made there under-

"No application for the grant of affiliation which does not have the concurrence/permission of the State Government for opening a new College (Government or Non-Government) shall be entertained. In the case of college introducing Bachelor's Degree/Master's Degree programme in Medical, Dental, Technical, Management, Agricultural, Nursing, Pharmacy Education permission of All India Statutory Body responsible for the coordinated and integrated development of education in the concerned discipline and of such authority as it may prescribe will also be necessary.

However, in case the schedule prescribed by the All India statutory Body for processing the proposals for starting the new institutions or new Courses Programme in some discipline(s) is at such variance that the Application Form duly completed and accompanied by all the requisite documents (including the approval of the All India Statutory Body) cannot be submitted either within the statutory dates prescribed by the University or even thereafter by condoning the delay to a reasonable extent the proposed institution may make an application to the Vice-Chancellor for provisional entertainment of the application Form (otherwise complete in all respects) pending approval/recognition of the proposed Institution by the All India Statutory Body. The said application shall also be accompanied by an affidavit of the Chairman of the Trust Society Managing Committee of the Institution to the effect that in case the request for provisional entertainment of the Application Form (otherwise complete in all respects) pending approval/recognition of the proposed institution by the All India Statutory Body is acceded to and the Application Form is processed in

accordance with the Statutes the decision of the University in the Application Form for affiliation whether favorable or unfavorable shall be binding on the Managing Committee if the institution. On consideration, the Vice-Chancellor may grant the request for provisional entertainment of the Application Form pending approval/ recognition of the proposed Institution by the All India Statutory Body provided the State Government has issued No Objection Certificate/Permission letter or has recommended to the All India Statutory Body the establishment of such Institution.

However, in case of Law College the University may consider the case regarding grant of affiliation of a new college without permission from the Bar Council of India. The University will not allow teaching in the Law College without approval by the Bar Council of India."

As per statute the following Law colleges (Non Govt.) have obtained the NOC from the Higher Education Dept., J&K state Govt. to run LL.B. 5 years as well as LL.B. 3 years for the year 2014-15. But the status for approval of the Bar Council of India in these colleges is as under-

"These colleges be given 31st October, 2014, as the final date to produce permission of the Bar Council of India failing which the teaching for the next semesters be not allowed as per the statutes."

After expiring the date of decision taken in the CDC meeting, the matter was submitted with proposal to call a meeting of the Principals of all the law colleges. The meeting could not be convened at the time as the concerned colleges approached the Authority for conducting the inspection of these colleges for the session 2014-15 as they conveyed that the BCI will give the approval on the basis of the Inspection reports of the current session.

Since, the annual inspections of these colleges have been conducted and grant of extension of affiliation for the session 2014-15 have been issued in favour of the above said four colleges.

It needs to be mentioned here that the Bar Council of India vide their letter No. BCI/D:2079/2014(LE/Affin) dated 4.12.2014 conveyed their approval in favour of KC Law College, Jammu with existing strength in respect of three year LL.B. as well as five year B.A. LL.B. courses upto 2013-14 only. The approval of the BCI is placed alongside for your kind perusal please.

But the approval of BCI in favour of rest of three colleges has not been received yet.

Hence, the case is submitted before the authority for consideration and further orders.

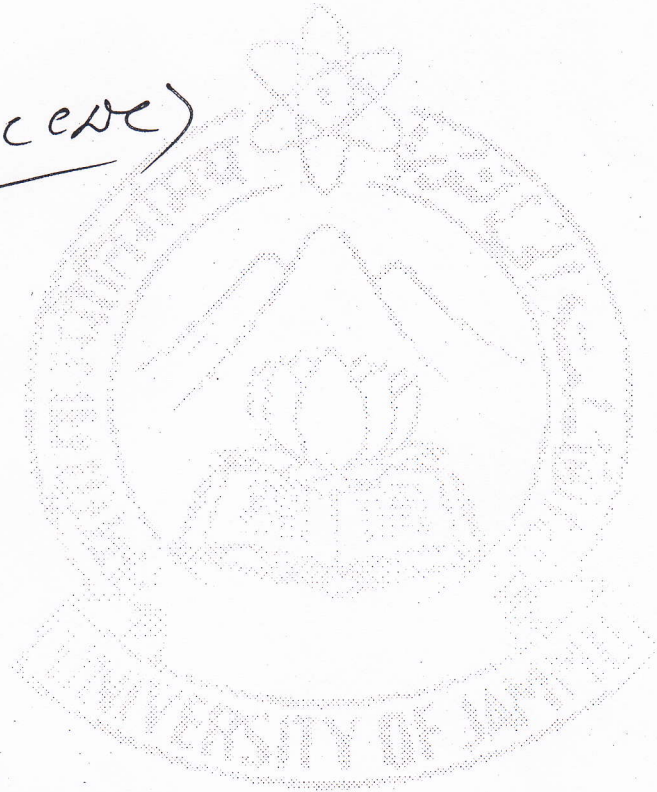

In order to inspect the Law colleges, an Inspection Committee vide order No. CDC/2015/CDC/2015/4688-94 dated 24.09.2015 was constituted with approval of the Vice-Chancellor for conducting the inspection of KC Law College, Akhnoor Road, Jammu for grant of renewal/extension of temporary affiliation to run B.A. LL.B. 5 year and LL.B. (Prof.) 3 year Course for the academic session **2015-16**. The committee after conducting the inspection of the college on 15.02.2016, has submitted the report which is placed alongside for your perusal.

The committee has observed the following points/deficiencies during the inspection of the college:

1. The committee observed that there was no entry in the stock register after 2008 though the college has purchased chairs for moot court in 2014-15. The deficiency was also pointed out last year but no efforts have been made to update the stock register.
2. Attendance registers of the students were not properly maintained. The committee instructed for proper maintenance of attendance record in future.
3. There is no internet connectivity in the Computer Lab nor any computer instructor has been engaged. The college has also not subscribed any on-line supreme court journal.
4. Librarian is not selected through proper selection committee.
5. The committee observed that the strength of permanent faculty is much below the required number i.e. 70% of the total strength. As per Bar Council of India norms, for teaching non-law subjects the faculty should be on full time basis whereas the teachers teaching political Science; English and Sociology in the college are engaged on part-time basis.
6. Salary component for the teaching faculty is not defined. The NET/SET and experienced teachers were getting same salary as is being paid to newly recruited teacher possessing simply LL.M. qualification.

However, the committee has recommended that extension of temporary affiliation for the session 2015-16 be granted in favour of the College.

Thus, based on the recommendations of the Inspection team, the Hon'ble Vice-Chancellor may kindly be requested to approve the placed alongside inspection report and also grant of renewal/extension of temporary affiliation in favour of college for the session **2015-16** in anticipation approval of the Competent Authority.

The office may further be authorized to sent the inspection report to the college & ask the college to fulfill the deficiencies within a period of one month pointed out by the Inspection team during inspection of the college.
