Observations/deficiencies

No access was available for online journals to the students and the same was pointed out-during the last inspection committee also.

The computer lab of the College needs Air-conditioning, upgradation and addition of computers and addition of printers.

Some of the equipment and books are still housed in the old premises of the college and the same should be available in the new campus.

The audio-visual room of the college needs improvement.

The equipment in the lab needs up-gradation and improvement from time to time and the faulty equipment be replaced on regular basis.

As per the latest guidelines of the University, the salary of the faculty members should be credited directly into the Accounts of the faculty members/other staff.

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The approach road to the College is in very bad shape and the inspection committee desired that the same be constructed / improved at the earliest.

Most of the staff members have been selected through the Selection Committee of the University and adhoc faculty members if any be appointed through the University Selection Committee and meeting of the management committee be held on regular basis.

FINAL RECOMMENDATIONS

After conducting inspection of the institute vis-a-vis the prescribed norms, the committee found the infrastructure, faculty and other facilities adequate for running B.Sc. Nursing Course.

The Committee, therefore, recommends extension of temporary/ provisional affiliation in favour of BEE ENN College of Nursing, Chak Bhalwal, Jammu for the session 2013-14 for imparting instructions to B.Sc. Nursing Course subject to the condition that the Chairman of the College shall give a compliance report of the deficiencies pointed out by the inspection committee before the start of the class work for the current session.

As authorized by the competent authority, the inspection committee recommends the enhancement of seats from 40 to 50 (including management quota seats @ 15% i.e. 42 (open merit seats) +8(management quota seats)) from the academic session 2013-14.
