Sir,

During the process of inspection of your college on 22.08.2012, the committee constituted by the Vice Chancellor observed some deficiencies for imparting instructions to Four Year Basic Nursing Course for the session 2012-13 which are given as under:-

- The team observed that the college still has old furniture in classrooms which needs to be changed to match the ambience of the new building and other facilities created for the students.
- The members were of a view that new models and charts be added to laboratories to equip them further.
- The college has added about 226 books for the library, but the number of titles purchased was far less than that prescribed under norms. The cataloguing of the books was not done, which was also pointed as a deficiency last year.
- No access was available for online journals to the students however few journals and INC newsletter are subscribed regularly by the college.
- The computer lab was shifted from old campus to new campus as desired by the committee members but proper furniture for the laboratory was still lacking.

You are, therefore, requested to submit the compliance report on the deficiencies pointed out by the inspection committee in the office of College Development Council as early as possible, so that grant of temporary/provisional affiliation for the session 2012-13 in favour of your college be confirmed.
