Observations/Deficiencies

1. The college is required to recruit the eligible faculty / Principal through the University Selection committee and the eligible faculty should be recruited before the start of class work for the current academic session.
2. Fundamental lab/ Community lab/ Paediatrics lab should be housed separately and more equipment should be added.
3. Nutrition lab is without water supply and needs addition of more equipment.
4. The equipment in the lab needs up-gradation and improvement from time to time and the faulty equipment be replaced on regular basis.





- 5. The library of the college needs improvement as it is having area less than prescribed under norms. No national newspapers and E-journals are available. Moreover, more number of books and number of titles should be added in the library.
- 6. More accommodation should be available for the faculty members.
- 7. As per the latest guidelines of the University, the salary of the faculty members should be credited directly into the Accounts of the faculty members/other staff.


FINAL RECOMMENDATIONS

After conducting inspection of the institute vis-a-vis the prescribed norms, the committee found the infrastructure, faculty and other facilities adequate for running B.Sc. Nursing Course.


The Committee, therefore, recommends extension of temporary/ provisional affiliation in favour of Rajiv Gandhi College of Nursing, Chak Bhalwal, Jammu for the session 2013-14 only subject to the condition that the Chairman of the College shall give a compliance report of the deficiencies pointed out by the inspection committee before the start of the class work of the current academic session.


As authorized by the competent authority, the inspection committee recommends the enhancement of seats from 40 to 50 {including management quota seats @ 15% i.e. 42 (open merit seats) +8(management quota seats)} from the academic session 2013-14 subject to the condition that the college has to remove the above stated deficiencies before the start of Academic Session. In case the deficiencies are not removed the enhanced intake shall be withdrawn.
