remarkable educationist, committed researcher, administrator, visionary and institution builder passed away on 23 April, 2022.

Prof. S.K. Shah was born in Srinagar (Kashmir), and he completed his M.Sc. with distinction and Ph.D. from the erstwhile University of Jammu and Kashmir, from the Jammu Campus, and post-doctoral studies in the United Kingdom and France. He started his career as a petrologist and geochemist, he served in the PG Department of Geology, University of Jammu and Kashmir and later at the University of Jammu for more than four decades. Besides, teaching and research he occupied administrative decision making positions.

He also worked as a Senior Scientific Officer at the Wadia Institute of Himalayan Geology.

He was the voting member of the Cambrian Sub-Commission of the International Union of Geological Sciences for ten years, representing Asia. He was a Fellow of the Palaeontological Society of India and is also fellow of the Geological Society of India.

Prof. S.K. Shah received recognition for the naming of a fossil genus Shahaspis after him in the journal Palaeontology (London). He also received the L. Rama Rao Centenary Lifetime achievement award for outstanding research work in Palaeontology and Stratigraphy from the Geological Society of India and Prof. R. C. Misra Memorial Lifetime achievement award for outstanding work in Geological Sciences from the Palaeontological Society of India.

was born on 13 January, 1938 in Jammu and he died on 10 May, 2022 at Mumbai.

His dedication brought about many changes in Santoor playing.
