Resolved to formulate, update and reorient the syllabi and courses of study of B.A/B.Sc./B.Com/B.Com (Hons.) and B.A. (Hons.) in the subject of Environmental Sciences for Semester I and II under Choice Based Credit system at Undergraduate level courses for adoption for Examinations to be held in the below mentioned years.

SEMESTER- I Change 70%

Dec.2019, Dec. 2020 and Dec. 2021

SEMESTER- II Change 70%

May 2020 , May 2021 and May 2022

It was also further **Resolved** that reappearing candidates prior to 2019-2020 semester batch, the existing syllabus will continue for two more years.

- a. Further resolved that each semester would have 2 credits course of theory. Question paper will consist of **THREE sections "A", "B" and "C"**. **Section A** will consist of **3 short answer type questions of 6 marks each**, representing all units i.e., at least ONE from each unit. All the questions would be compulsory. Candidate has to restrict the answers in 70 to 80 words. **Section "B"** will consist of **3 medium answer type questions of 14 marks each**, representing all units i.e., at least ONE from each Unit with internal choice. All the questions would be compulsory. Candidate has to restrict the answers in 250 to 300 words. **Section "C"** will consist of **2 long answer type questions of 20 marks each**, out of which candidates have to **attempt only ONE**. Candidate has to restrict the answers in 500 to 600 words.
- b. ~~Internal assessment test of 20 marks~~ would be based on questions from syllabus (10 marks) and from field trip visits (10 marks).
