**Item No.1 Partial Modification in the PG Courses in Sociology (Both CBCS and Non-CBCS)**

The members discussed the new 96 credit courses which were recently adopted vide notification No. F.Acad/II/18/1501-1520 Dt. 07.05.2018 for CBCS in the main campus and Notification No. F.Acad/II/18/8602-8621 Dt. 09.08.2018 for Non CBCS.

The members after discussion resolved that in order to bring the course structure and the number of courses in P.G Sociology at par with the other subjects in the Faculty of Social Sciences, the partial modification should be done. After partial modification, the following course structures were adopted for CBCS and Non CBCS. In the revised course structure the course content remains to be the same but the course structure has undergone less than 20% of the change.


