The External examinations in theory shall consist of the following: Five (5) short answers to the questions representing all units/syllabi i.e. at least one from each unit (without detail explanation having 70 to 80 words in approximately 6 minutes and having 3 marks for each answer to the question (All Compulsory). Five (5) medium answers to the questions representing all units/syllabi i.e. at least one from each unit (with explanation having 250-300 words in approximately 12 minutes and having 7 marks for each answer to the question (All Compulsory). Four/Five (4/5)long answers to the questions (two to be attempted) representing whole of the syllabi with detailed analysis/explanation/critical evaluation/solution to the stated problems within 500 – 600 words in approximately 30 minutes and having 15 marks each answer to the question. Total time 2 ½ hours only. Note 1: However, for English and Music subjects the structure shall be as per note/instructions given in the syllabi to the paper setters. Note 2: Skilled based courses shall be evaluated internally as per the guidelines laid in
