Eligibility of External Examiner An examiner for collegiate programme should be a lecturer or above in a college of Nursing with M.Sc (N) in concerned subject and minimum 3 years of teaching experience.

No person shall be appointed as an examiner in any of the subjects of the professional examinations leading to the award of degree of 4 year Basic B.sc(N) Nursing unless;-

- a) He/ she has at least five years teaching experience in the subject concerned in a Nursing College affiliated to recognized University as a Faculty position
- b) Is of the rank of an Associate professor or equivalent and above, with the requisite qualification and experience as given in above sub- clause (a). Provided that when an Associate Professor or equivalent and above are not available, an Asstt. Professor of 5 years standing as Assistant Professor with requisite qualification and experience in the subject may be appointed as examiner
- c) Non- Nursing teachers of the rank of Associate Professor or equivalent and above, or in their absence, Assistant Professor with 5 years standing as Assistant Professor entrusted with the teaching of Nursing students, may be appointed as examiner/s in their concerned subjects provided they fulfill eligibility conditions and have at least 5 years teaching experience of a Nursing Degree College affiliated to a recognized University or a recognized Post Graduate Institute.

Resolved that an examiner for collegiate programme shall be a lecturer or above in a college of Nursing with M.Sc(N) in concerned subject and minimum 3 years of teaching experience.

- Nursing Research & Statistics- Nursing Research should be of 50 marks and Statistics of 25
 - Minimum pass marks shall be 40% for English only
- Theory and Practical exams for Introduction to computer to be conducted as College exam
- Minimum pass marks shall be 50 % in each of the Theory and practical papers separately. A candidate must have minimum of 80% attendance (irrespective of the kind of absence) in
- A candidate must have 100% attendance in each of the practical areas before award of
- A candidate has to pass in theory and practical exam separately in each of the paper.
- If a candidate fails in either theory or practical paper he/she has to re-appear for both the 12.
- 13.
- Maximum number of attempts permitted for each paper is 3 including first attempt A candidate failing in more then two subjects will not be promoted to the next year.

Further this penalty will be for each year per programme and for next three years, failing which the institution shall be declared Unsuitable (Not recognized). The penalty will be considered with effect from 1st April 2012. The penalty will be considered for the institutions which are established before April 2010.

- (iv) The nursing institution can have all the nursing programmes in the same building but with requisite programme wise infrastructure however labs can be shared.
- (v) If the trust has some other educational programmes, the nursing programme shall be in separate block /floor with prescribed sq feet area.
- (vi) Nursing programme may be in hospital premises with a condition that it shall be in separate block /floor with prescribed sq feet area.
- (vii) Long lease by the govt. will be considered however rented building shall not be considered as their own building.

EXAMINATION:

- Maximum of 5 grace marks for each subject is not permitted, and grace marks should not exceed 5 marks in total marks for one academic year in theory paper only.
- An examiner for collegiate programme should be a lecturer or above in a college of nursing with M.Sc.(N) in concerned subject and minimum of 3 years of teaching experience.
- 25. An examiner for B.Sc.(N) programme shall be only M.Sc.(N) qualified faculty.
- The number of attempts for examination has been waived off. However to appear for final year examination, the candidate shall have cleared all the previous examination.
- 27. No institution shall submit average internal marks of the total students more than 75% i.e. if 40 students are admitted in a course the average score of the 40 students shall not exceed 75% of total internal marks.

Minutes of meeting.

. A meeting of Board of Studies for Nursing was held today on 03-07-2013 at 08.00 a m. of in the Office Chamber of the Principal, Govt. Medical College, Jammu to have deliberations on amendment of statutes governing Basic B.Sc. (N) four years and Post Basic B. Sc. (N) Two years programme. The following members were present in the meeting:-

- 1. Principal, AMT School, Jammu.
- 2. Principal, Bee Enn College of Nursing, Jammu.
- 3. Professor, Pity Koul, School of Health Sciences, IGNOU, Delhi.
- 4. Dr. Raj Rani, Principal, Govt. College of Nursing Amritsar.

The following issues were deliberated:-

- 1. The members resolved that minimum Pass %age shall be 45% for English only.
- 2. The members agreed that Five marks in total shall be awarded for one academic year only in theory paper that too if the candidate is failing in one subject.
- 3. The members resolved that only provision of re-checking (Re-totaling) will be allowed and re-evaluation will not be allowed in any case.
- 4. Eligibility of External Examiners: It was resolved that only Assistant Professor/Lecturer with five years teaching experience can be External Examiner for Basic B.Sc. Nursing Programme and Post Basic B.Sc. Nursing Programme.
- 5. It was resolved that if the candidate fails in 1st year of B.Sc. Nursing Course in three or more than three subjects, he /she shall not be promoted to second year until he/she clears all the subject of 1st year. However, with regard to 2nd year, 3^{rd year} and 4th year, the candidate can be promoted but he/she has to have to clear all previous examinations before appearing for final examination.
- 6. It was resolved that if a candidate secures 75% or more marks in aggregate She /he should be awarded distinction However if a candidate secures 75% or more marks in one or more subjects she /he may be awarded distinction in that subject/s also.
- . 7. It was resolved that a candidate can seek admission to Post Basic B. Sc Nursing Programme only if the candidate is RN & RM. However, if a candidate is unable to produce the RN & RM Certificate at the time of admission such candidates may be admitted provisionally to the programme for six months and she /he she may be required to submit the certificate within six months of admission in the event if the candidate is not able to produce the certificate within stipulated period his/her admission will be out rightly cancelled and candidate can not have any type of claim in this regard.
- 8. It was resolved that the Principals of both the Nursing Colleges will prepare guidelines and sample Question papers of all the subjects of B. Sc. & Post B.Sc. Nursing Programme and put before Principal & Dean, Govt. Medical College, Jammu for further forwarding to the Controller of Examinations, University of Jammu.

- iii. Student shall be medically fit.
- iv Students appearing in 10+2 examination in Science conducted by National Institute of Open School with 45% marks.
- vi. Student shall be admitted once in a year.

NOTE: Simultaneous attendance in other courses is not permitted. It will be applicable to all the above courses.
