

# UNIVERSITY OF JAMMU

## NOTIFICATION

It is notified for the information of all concerned that the eligibility of the candidates who have applied for the post(s) of Assistant Professor in various subjects advertised by the University of Jammu, Jammu in the various Newspapers w.e.f. 31.08.2013 onwards shall be determined in the light of the qualification as mentioned below:-

- i. Good academic record as defined by the concerned university with at least 55% marks (or an equivalent grade in a point scale wherever grading system is followed) at the Master's Degree level in a relevant subject from an Indian University, or an equivalent degree from an accredited foreign university.
- ii. NET/SET shall remain the minimum eligibility condition for recruitment and appointment of Lecturers in Universities/Colleges/Institutions.
- iii. Provided, however, that candidates, who are or have been awarded Ph.D. degree in compliance of the University Grants Commission (Minimum Standards and Procedure for Award of Ph.D. Degree) Regulations, 2009, shall be exempted from the requirement of the minimum eligibility condition of NET/SLET/SET for recruitment and appointment of Assistant Professor or equivalent positions in Universities/Colleges/ Institutions.
- iv. However, candidates seeking exemption from NET/SLET/SET are required to produce a bona-fide certificate from the concerned University(s) to the effect that the said candidate have been awarded Ph.D degree in conformity with the UGC Regulations i.e. all the conditions laid down in University Grants Commission (minimum standards and procedure for Award of Ph.D Degree) Regulations, 2009 are satisfied by them at the time of submitting their Ph.D thesis.

### PERCENTAGE EQUIVALENCE OF GRADE POINTS FOR A SEVEN POINT SCALE:

#### NOTE:

B in the Seven Point Scale with letter grades O,A,B,C,D,E & F shall be regarded as equivalent of 55% wherever the grading system is followed:

#### SEVEN POINT SCALE

|-----------------|--------------------|------------------------|
| O=Outstanding   | 5.50-6.00          | 75-100                 |
| A=Very Good     | 4.50-5.49          | 65-74                  |
| B=Good          | 3.50-4.49          | 55-64                  |
| C=Average       | 2.50-3.49          | 45-54                  |
| D=Below Average | 1.50-2.49          | 35-44                  |
| E=Poor          | 0.50-1.49          | 25-34                  |
| F=Fail          | 0.00-0.49          | 00-24                  |

A relaxation of 5% may be provided at the Graduate and Master's level for the Scheduled Caste/Scheduled Tribe/Differently-abled (Physically and Visually differently-abled) categories for the purpose of eligibility and for assessing good academic record during direct recruitment to teaching positions.

A relaxation of 5% may be provided from 55% to 50% of the marks to the Ph.D. Degree holders, who have obtained their Master's Degree prior to 19th September, 1991.

This is issued in the light of the Hon'ble Supreme Court Judgement dated 15.03.2015 in the case titled "P. Suseela and ors. Vs. University Grants Commission and ors" and as per approval received from Hon'ble Chancellor of the University.
